



Semi finals and Championship Overtime Rules.

Overtime Periods and On Ice Manpower

1. First period. 4 on 4 for 5 minutes, stop time
2. Second Period. 3 on 3 for 3 minutes, straight time
3. Third Period. 2 on 2 for 3 minutes, straight time
4. Fourth Period. 1 on 1 unlimited time, straight time

Line Changes

All player changes including goalies will be done on the fly.

Penalties

Penalties incurred in regulation time and not completely served in regulation time, shall carry over into the overtime period (as a stop time penalty). Teams will start overtime short-handed depending on the carryover penalties (exception is coincidental penalties).

Any carryover of penalties or penalties occurring in the first overtime period will result in a team playing shorthanded.

- If a team is shorthanded by 1 player teams will play 4 on 3
- If a team is shorthanded by 2 players, the teams will play 5 on 3.

After the penalties are served the manpower will be corrected at the first stoppage of play.

If a penalty is carried over into the 2nd overtime the teams will start 4-3 or 5 on 3, once the penalty is served the manpower will be corrected at the first stoppage of play.

Any penalties occurring in the 2nd overtime or later will result in a penalty shot if it causes a team to be shorthanded.

Penalty Shot

- The clock will stop during the penalty shot.
- The coach will choose a player from the ice to take the penalty shot, when the stoppage of play occurs.
